Class name: Non-Separating ECFE Class

Description: *A time for adults (parents, grandparents, caregivers, etc.) and children to come to school together!* This class is designed for adults and toddlers (12-24 months of age) who are not quite ready to separate. A typical class would include together time, circle time and snack. This class will give you a chance to spend some uninterrupted time together participating in crafts, games, and other activities.

Age: Classes are designed for learners from 12 months to 24 months of age (Older children and siblings welcome)

Time: 8:15am - 9:30am

Early Childhood Family Education (ECFE)



Class Name: Separating ECFE Class

Description: *A time for adults (parents, grandparents, caregivers, etc.) and children to come to school together!* This class is designed for adults and children eighteen months through pre-kindergarten age. In the separating ECFE class, adults and children engage in crafts & games, a short circle, and snack. Snack is followed by parent conversation led by an educator in a separate room while children engage in structured play with center staff. Parent conversations focus around child-related topics such as controlling emotions, expressing emotions, following directions, promoting independence, self-help skills, and interactions with adults and other children. Choose from one of two weekly classes below:

Age: Classes are designed for learners from eighteen months to prekindergarten age

Time: 10:00 am - 11:30 am (choose one of these sessions)
5:15 pm - 6:45 pm

Dates: January 14th through March 25th (Mondays only)

Fees: Class fees vary from \$24 - \$60

No family will be turned away for an inability to pay

Together Time



Class begins with activities such as crafts and games that adults and children do together. These activities have been designed by a licensed Early Childhood Teacher. Activities enhance children's learning and give parents ideas of skills to work on at home.

Parent Conversation



Adults participate in a discussion led by a licensed parent educator. Parent conversations focus around child-related topics such as controlling emotions, expressing emotions, following directions, etc.

Childrens' Time



While adults are in (discussion group), children learn through structured play activities led by an Early Childhood Teacher. Structured play helps children grow and develop socially, emotionally & cognitively, as well as enhance their communication and motor skills.
