

**Class Name:** Separating ECFE Class

<u>Description</u>: A time for adults (parents, grandparents, caregivers, etc.) and children to come to school together! This class is designed for adults and children eighteen months through pre-kindergarten age. In the separating ECFE class, adults and children engage in crafts & games, a short circle, and snack. Snack is followed by parent conversation led by an educator in a separate room while children engage in structured play with center staff. Parent conversations focus around child-related topics such as controlling emotions, expressing emotions, following directions, promoting independence, self-help skills, and interactions with adults and other children. Choose from one of two weekly classes below:

Age: Classes are designed for learners from eighteen months to prekindergarten age
